### 3. Registration

Registration can be made on line through the web site (<http://event.toptour.co.jp/ecas/icpp2008/system/>). In order to proceed, please first obtain the 'registration number' by providing such information as your name, address, and affiliation. You can then sign in to register, to reserve a hotel (or to modify/cancel the reservation), and to buy tickets for the banquet, excursion, and optional tours. Please note that this web site is different from the online abstract submission site (PERAS): even if you have already registered to the PERAS system, you have to register again for the conference registration.

Early registration will be accepted until **July 31, 2008**. Late registration through the above web site can be made until **August 31, 2008**. After this date, only the on-site registration will be available during **September 7-12, 2008** at the conference registration desk in Fukuoka International Congress Center.

Post-deadline submission of abstracts can be received until **August 31, 2008**, by sending an e-mail to [ICPP@triam.kyushu-u.ac.jp](mailto:ICPP@triam.kyushu-u.ac.jp) including your name, e-mail address, address, affiliation, and the abstract. Each submission will be reviewed by the Program Committee, and the acceptance will be notified by e-mail before **September 7, 2008**.

## Visa application:

The documents, along with the official invitation letter from the ICPP2008, will be sent to you after the payments of the registration fee is confirmed.

## 4. Equipments

### Guidelines for Poster Preparations:

Each poster will be assigned one poster board with a usable area of 2.1 m by 1.8 m (height x width). Information on a poster should attract attention. All display material should be prepared in advance. Title strips of the posters should be prepared by the authors. Posters can be displayed from 10:30 to 18:30 each day. Participants are requested to remove them by 18:30.

### Guidelines for the Oral Presentations:

Presentation should be given using a PC and connected projector prepared by LOC. Please make a duplicate of your presentation files (ppt or pdf ) in the desktop folder (/desktop/ICPP2008/presentation number/) and check the projection of your file before presentation: it is the presenter's responsibility to make sure that his or her slides are displayed as desired. Since the LOC prepared PC and projector are adjusted correctly, it is enough to check only the PC monitor.

Prepared PC is operated by Windows XP (English version) and both powerpoint 2003 and 2007 are available. In addition a preview room (504 at 5F) is open from 8:30 to 17:00 for checking your presentation file in advance. The detail information will be sent to all presenters (plenary, invited and oral) until the end of August, 2008.

## 5. Financial Support

If you are entitled to receive the financial support for participants from developing countries, please come to the registration desk **either between 14-18pm on Sunday, Sept. 7, or 13-14pm on Monday, Sept. 8** to receive the grant. Please note that the application to the financial support program is already closed, and that the recipients and the amount of the support have been determined on the ground of scientific as well as financial considerations by the congress chairman. The recipients have been notified by emails.

## 7. Map and access

### By subway and bus:

Take subway from the Fukuoka Domestic Terminals and get off at Hakata Station (The Domestic Terminals and the International Terminals are linked by free shuttle bus service) . Take Bus No.11, 19, or 50 from Hakata Station and get off at *Kokusaikaigijo-Sun Palace-mae*. The total fare is 430 Yen (subway: 250 Yen, bus: 180 Yen).

Time needed to reach Fukuoka International Congress Center: approximately 30 minutes from the Domestic Terminals.

### By subway:

Take subway from the Fukuoka Domestic Terminals to *Nakasu-kawabata*. (The Domestic Terminals and the International Terminals are linked by free shuttle bus service). At *Nakasu-kawabata*, transfer to the subway bound for *Kaizuka* and get off at *Gofukumachi*. Fukuoka International Congress Center is about a 15-minute walk from *Gofukumachi*. The fare is 250 Yen. Time needed: approximately 30 minutes from the Domestic Terminals.

### By taxi:

Taxis are available at both the Fukuoka International and the Domestic Terminals. The fare to Fukuoka International Congress Center is about 2,150 Yen. Time needed: approximately 20 minutes.

## 8. Welcome reception

The welcome reception will be held in the lobby on the 5th floor of the Fukuoka International Congress Center in the evening (16:00 ~ 20:00) of September 7, 2008 (Sunday). Please note that the location and the time have been changed from the previous announcement.

## 9. Banquet

Conference participants are welcome to attend the banquet that will be held at the Hotel Okura in the evening, **September 11, 2008** (Thursday). The



price of the ticket is 5,000 Yen/person. Participants who plan to attend the banquet are requested to register through the website at <https://event.toptour.co.jp/ecas/icpp2008/system/> and pay the banquet fee by **August 31, 2008**. Participants who registered beforehand will receive a banquet ticket at the reception desk of the congress. (Participants who register on site can buy the banquet tickets at the registration desk). The ticket should be shown at the entrance of the banquet hall.

## 11. Excursion

A half-day excursion to Mt. Aso and the surrounding area will be organized on **September 10** (Wednesday), after the morning session (price: 5,000 Yen/person). Mount Aso is the largest active volcano in Japan, and is among the largest in the world. Its peak is 1592m above sea level, and its caldera is 25 km across north to south and 18 km across east to west. The west side of the main crater is accessible by road for visitors to observe the volcano, which continuously emits smoke and has occasional eruptions.

Note: People with a history of asthma or other reactive airway diseases are advised to avoid the area near the crater. The crater area may be closed without advance notice depending on the conditions of the weather and the volcanic activity.

### **DAZAIFU, city of Ancient Culture**

Today's Dazaifu City owes its name to the ancient office of *Dazaifu* (Government-General Headquarters) which, established approximately 1,300 years ago, ruled the entire Kyushu for a period of some 500 years. Within the city, there are many historical sites which serve as the reminders of the past, including the ruins of the *Dazaifu* itself, the *Mizuki* (“Water Fortress”), *Kanzeonji* Temple, *Chikuzen Kokubunji* Temple, and *Dazaifu Tenmangu* Shrine.
